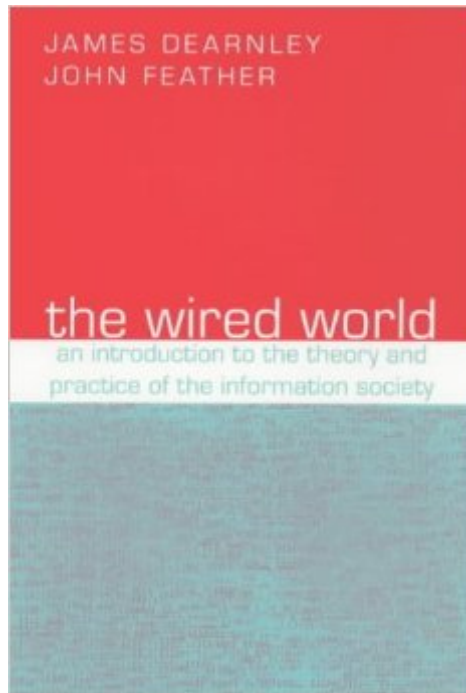

The Wired World: An Introduction To The Theory And Practice Of The Information Society



Synopsis

The term "information society" has been well used, primarily as a buzzword for technological advances in computing and telecommunications and the widespread uptake of digital technology. The concept of an information society has been developed and promoted by academic theorists, governments and popular authors since the 1960s.
